Taxonomic analyses of items and scales from most personality tests showed confusing structures. Neuroticism

However analyses of structure of lexical items yielded a similar structure of peer and self report. Agreeableness

This lead to the consensual structure known as the the "Big 5"

Conscientiousness

Extraversion

Openness
